


#### Public Debt

- Central Government debt \$2.2 billion



• Eye Ward - refurbished and commission in October 2015





 Steel Structure - adjusted to four levels and will accommodate: Accidents and Emergencies; Laboratory; Imaging Unit; and Out-patient clinics.

- Doctors' Quarters remodeled






### Health Care FACTS

- 43 new nurses and 9 doctors (House officers) recruited in
   2015
- 17 specialist doctors contracted from Cuba to complement the current staff.
- 3 Medical laboratory Technicians and 3 X-ray technicians will soon be returning from studies.
- 5 scholarships provided to doctors to pursue specialized training in the areas of Obstetrics/Gynecology, Pediatrics, Anesthesiology and Pathology in Cuba and China.




















### CARRIACOU & PETIT MARTINIQUE

### 2016, key projects include:

- Road Works \$2.0 million
- Agriculture Programme \$1.0 million
- Sports and Culture Support Programme \$1.0 million
- Asphalt and Concrete Works \$450,000
- Petit Martinique Playing Field- \$400,000

2016 total allocation for Carriacou and Petit Martinique - \$13.4 million of which \$4.4 million is earmarked for capital expenditure.





















#### TRADE & EXPORT DEVELOPMENT

- Value of Total Exports 2016 \$671.4 m (projected).
- Value of Food Import Bill Jan Sept 2015 \$145.2 m.
   A decrease of 6.0 % over the same in 2014
- Food imports = 20% of Total Imports.
   Will reduce this Bill to no more than 10% of Total Imports over the next 5 years.










### SUPPORT FOR SMALL BUSINESS DEVELOPMENT

- By the end of December 2015, the Fund is projected to disburse \$1.65 million resulting in 325 jobs.
- The 2016 Budget provides an allocation of \$4 m which will result in the creation of **650 jobs.**






