The Government of Grenada received financing from the World Bank toward the cost of the **Unleashing the Blue Economy of the Caribbean Project (UBEC)** and intends to apply part of the proceeds for consulting services.

The consulting services (“the Services”) include the expertise in engineering or related areas’ in accordance with the Loan Agreement and World Bank Procurement Regulation for IPF Borrowers, to:

1. Provision of technical services associated with: (i) Agriculture or Industrial Engineering, and (ii) experience in cold storage, refrigeration design.

The **Ministry of Economic Development, Planning and Cooperatives** now invites eligible individuals (“Consultants”) to indicate their interest in providing the Services. Interested Consultants should provide information demonstrating that they have the required qualifications and relevant experience to perform the Services. The shortlisting criteria are:

- At least ten years working in the field of designing, installation, and maintenance of commercial/industrial refrigeration systems.
- Experience in cold storage or refrigeration design.
- At Least a first degree in Agricultural Engineering or Industrial Engineering or related field.
- Solicit the input of the relevant stakeholders at an appropriate time in the design process.
- Produce scope of works in sufficient detail with cost estimates for building for the facility so designed.

The attention of interested Consultants is drawn to Section III, paragraphs, 3.14, 3.16, and 3.17 of the World Bank’s “Procurement Regulations for IPF Borrowers” July 2016, revised November 2017, and August 2018 (“Procurement Regulations”), setting forth the World Bank’s policy on conflict of interest.

The Consultant will be selected in accordance with the Individual Qualification Selection (ICS) method set out in the Procurement Regulations.
