## GRENADA'S FINANCE MINISTER TO ADDRESS ORGANIZATION OF THE PETROLEUM EXPORTING COUNTRIES (OPEC) FUND DEVELOPMENT FORUM IN AUSTRIA

St. George's, Grenada - June 12, 2025 – Grenada's Minister for Finance, Hon. Dennis Cornwall, will depart the State on Sunday to attend the prestigious OPEC Fund Development Forum (OFDF25), scheduled for June 17, 2025, in Vienna, Austria.

Grenada's delegation at the OPEC Fund Development Forum will also include Ambassador Andrea St. Bernard, Special Envoy for Development and Investment to the Government of Grenada, and Mr. Damian Dolland, Lead Consultant for Project Polaris.
