The Regulatory Analyst will be responsible for providing essential analytical support within the Regulatory, Accounting & Economic (RAE) Affairs Department. This role focuses on conducting regulatory, economic and accounting analyses related to both the electricity and the water & sewerage sector, supporting tariff setting, regulatory compliance, and policy development.

- Analyse utility data and validate tariff-related studies
- Review license applications and sustainability programmes
- Prepare reports on tariffs, policies, and water resource issues
- Address consumer complaints on economic/tariff matters
- Benchmark utility performance and recommend improvements
- Support stakeholder consultations and regulatory framework development

- Bachelor's degree in Economics, Accounting, Finance or Public Administration.
- Minimum of three years analytical experience, preferably in utilities or regulation.
