

FISCAL SUMMARY January 2018

- 1. Current Revenue for January 2018 was \$64.4m, which was \$10.0m above the target and \$4.3m more than the collections for January 2017.
- 2. Grants received in January 2018 amounted to \$1.2m.
- 3. Total expenditure for the month of January was \$47.5m, \$4.6m below the targeted \$52.1m.
- 4. A primary surplus of \$20.8m was realised for the month of January 2018, exceeding the targeted \$13.8m.
